MARMARIS 7 DAYS NATURE ROUTE

This is a 7 day (Saturday - Saturday) sailing trip starting from Marmaris and is meant for people interested in exploring the beautiful nature and animals of the turkish coast.

Please note that all restaurants and activities listed are only suggestions, and are not included in the price. The trip can be changed according to your wishes, meaning stops can be added or removed.

Day 1



Marmaris - the Turtle Beach

The plan for the first day is to arrive on a saturday in Marmaris and get to the Marina. Your check in on the boat will be at 5 PM and you will spend the night there.

Marmaris is special for Marmaris Dalyan Turtle Beach Mud Bath and Kings Tombs, the UNESCO-World Heritage ruins.

Things to do:

- experience outdoor sports like horse safari or diving
- visit the Marmaris peninsula and find the Tulipa armena, a beautiful flower introduced during the Ottoman period
- Nimara Cave is near Marmaris. Since ancient times, the cave was used as a place of worshiping the cult

of the Mother Goddess Leto

Food and drinks:

- Karen Brasserie Steakhouse with a private beach for your enjoying time
- Hacis Cafe Restaurant Bar popular for its parmos and offers a variety of vegetarian and vegan options
- Cosy Corner restaurant with a variety of different cuisines

Ekincik, snorkeling paradise

A pleasant sail to Ekincik is known as the snorkler's paradise. Relax in the mud baths and swim in the clear water.

Things to do:

 visit the ancient site of Caunos and viewing the Lycian Tombs set high on the hillside

Food and drinks:

- Asma Altı small family run restaurant with a great selection of food
- Captan Beach Cafe Bar great for refreshments at the beach

Kapi Creek, where the Eleonora's falcons are

Enjoy your sail to Kapi Creek and remember, it is cash only. There is a good walk up to the summit of the mountain which overlooks the creek. Views from the top are magnificent and, if lucky, you may even spot a pair of Eleonora's falcons that frequent the summit.

- visit the Butterfly Valley home to diverse butterfly species


Food and drinks:
